<u>Mission Be</u> is a not for profit organization bringing mindfulness to schools, impacting 36 schools with our eight week in class mindful education program and training an additional 720 teachers in our 18 hour weekend trainings. With these two models we have impacted an estimated 30,000 children in New York and Silicon Valley since 2013. Directions: Long Island Expressway to Exit 41 North **OR** Northern State Parkway to Exit 35 North. Head north on Rte. 106/107 for approximately half a mile. You will pass Whole Foods shopping center on your right and the Milleridge Inn Restaurant. Bear LEFT at the split onto Route 107 North staying in the right lane. You will pass two traffic lights.
