- ▲ **We use a sliding fee scale, which starts at just \$5 per therapy session with a one-time intake fee of \$45***
- ▲ We offer individual, couple, family and group counseling for children and adults at a minimal cost.
- ▲ We work with clients from diverse demographic and socio-economic groups as well as multi-cultural backgrounds.
- ▲ The charge for a comprehensive psychological testing is no more than \$650.

SERVICES

Psychological Assessment and Testing

- ▲ Children and adolescents, including IQ testing and attention deficit hyperactivity disorder and learning disability batteries.
- ▲ Adults interested in learning more about their intellectual abilities, personality and/or neuropsychological status.

DIRECTIONS BY CAR

From Points West: Take the LIE (I-495) east to Exit 39 and make a left at the light (Glen Cove Road north). Go north for 2 miles; turn right (east) on Northern Blvd. (Route 25A). LIU Post is 2 miles on the right. Enter at the east entrance (2nd entrance). Proceed straight. Lodge A is on your left.

From Points East: Take the LIE (I-495) to exit 41N (Route 107). Turn right (north) onto 107 north. Proceed to Northern Blvd. (Route 25A). Turn left (west) at Northern Blvd. LIU Post is on your left. Enter at the east entrance (1st entrance). Proceed straight. Lodge A is on your left.
